The technical tour Tuesday afternoon, Walking Brewery Tour Tuesday evening, and TRB social on Wednesday evening are optional and require purchasing a ticket (available on the website). All registrations for TRB will be done through the website listed above. Early registration rates apply until April 7. Note there are two types of registration:

- 1. As a TRB member/friend, you have the **option to register for TRB only** (all TRB AEP80 member/friends qualify as Members for registration): includes exhibit reception event on Monday evening and **only transportation sessions/workshops Tuesday Thursday** (scheduled to be done by noon on Thursday).
- 2. The joint registration includes the reception and *all* technical sessions/workshops Monday Thursday.

The abstract due date is **January 6**; this will be extended, but submit an abstract ASAP to secure your presentation slot. For presenters, please know that presentations will be 15 minutes with an additional 3 minutes for questions and answers (and 2 minutes to switch over to the next speaker).

For those submitting a paper (optional for TRB members/friends), please follow instructions online. **Papers are due March 20.**

TRB and INCE volunteers are busy organizing several transportation-related sessions and workshops. Make sure to submit an abstract on one of these topics to ensure the session is held. Note that some of the sessions listed below may be scheduled for Monday due to volume of presentations – we will do our best to put the most TRB-relevant sessions on Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday morning (followed by an **AEP80 business meeting before lunch**). Registration to the *joint* conference will be required to attend the sessions on Monday. There are also many other sessions that you may find interesting/relevant.
