Averaged by 5 minutes for December 2015 through November 2016 (every weekday)












Eisenhower Expressway Improvements – Cook County, Illinois




Jane Byrne Interchange Reconstruction – Chicago, Illinois
















Proposed Ramps at Harlem Avenue




























Chicago Noise Walls


- Mayor Daley did not approve noise wall construction in City of Chicago
- 2010 updates to 23 CFR 772 allowed viewpoints solicitation, and noise walls started to be approved




























































FINAL 2017 IDOT POLICY: Viewpoints Solicitation Timing

The viewpoints solicitation may occur in either Phase I Preliminary Engineering and Environmental or in Phase II Design.

- If a project involves a Section 106 (historic) property, the entire project is recommended to have viewpoints solicitation voting in Phase I to fulfill Section 106 process requirements in Phase I.
- If a project has funding beyond Phase I included in IDOT's five-year plan (Proposed Highway Improvement Program), voting can occur in Phase I due to the short timeframe prior to design.
- If a project does not have funding beyond Phase I included in IDOT's fiveyear plan, voting should occur in Phase II due to the long term nature of the project.
